A monopoly is being maintained at the heart of the NSW legal system, for the majority of law practices.

The Law Society of NSW is being maintained as the monopolist, operating through its wholly owned and controlled insurance subsidiary, Lawcover Insurance.

There is an obvious conflict of interest in a regulatory body providing insurance to the entities it regulates.

We are bringing this to the attention of Members of Parliament given the strong bipartisan support for competition.
